

Weeping Japanese Maple 'Crimson Queen'

Acer palmatum 'weeping'



Crimson Queen is a lace leaf type Japanese Red Maple that sports branches of bright crimson-red which persist through out the entire growing season. The leaves are a medium delicate lacy dark red. Crimson Queen Maple fall color, is a deep scarlet red. This is a strong growing lace leaf tree with beautiful cascading branches. The most common variety of Weeping Laceleaf Japanese Red Maple.
